1. *Complete the **Two** assigned Knowledge Reviews at the end of each segment of the PADI Deep Diver Manual, **PRIOR** to the first day of class. Failure to complete and turn in these assignments will preclude me from participating in any class activities and result in forfeiture of the class without refund.

2. All text and support materials are required for each academic development session. If you do not bring in your materials you will be required to purchase new materials.

4. Students are required to have in their possession a Mask, Snorkel and Fins for the all the water training segments. This equipment is not rented and is available for purchase in the store.

5. Students are required to have in their possession all equipment necessary to complete the Open Water dives including a flashlight, whistle, signaling device and a pony bottle is recommended for additional safety.

6. The student understands that there are **Four** Open Water dives required for certification. These dives are pre-scheduled (unless prior arrangements were made). Failure to "show-up" to the diving activities will result in a \$50.00 fee of which will include rescheduling dives to a later date.

I, _____ am enrolled in a SELF-STUDY PADI Deep Diver Class. The ONLY way for us to conduct this class in 2 days is for you to both read the Deep Diver Manual and watch the Deep Diver Video. **YOU MUST COMPLETE THE TWO KNOWLEDGE REVIEWS IN THE BOOK BY THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN A FORFEITURE OF THE CLASS WITH NO REFUND.** We cannot start your class until this requirement is met. We have 5 instructors on staff and are open 7 days a week to help you with any questions you may have while studying. There will be no exceptions to this requirement. Please understand that we are making this as clear as possible to avoid disappointment later. We will be happy to change the start date of your class ONE time with no charge as long as you give us at least 72 hours notice prior to start time. For less than 72 hours notice there will be a \$100.00 fee to reschedule. Additional rescheduling will keep incurring a \$100.00 fee. If you are not sure of when you can take the class, don't schedule it until you are sure to avoid paying fees.

Refund policy:

Due to the limited capacity of each class, we do not offer refunds if you only complete a portion of the class. We will issue you a referral letter that can be used to complete your class at any PADI dive center world-wide during the next 12 months (each dive center may have different fees to do this), or you may come back and finish the class within 12 months with us at no charge.

Gratuities:

As with any service industry, tipping is customary. Your dive instructor is professionally trained and is here not only to teach you how to scuba dive, but also to ensure your safety and enjoyment. While this is voluntary, the normal customary amount is 10-15% of the class price paid.
